- Certification or Certification-Eligible as a School Counselor and/or License or License-Eligible as a Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC).
- Demonstrated commitment to, and experience working with, diverse populations
- Demonstrated experience in counseling in school settings
- Existing record or strong potential to develop scholarship through presentations and/or publications
