

**POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT**  
**ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING**

The Department of Counseling at The University of Texas at San Antonio invites applications for one tenure track full-time position in Clinical Mental Health Counseling starting in the fall of 2020. The Department of Counseling houses CACREP accredited M.S., M.Ed., and Ph.D. Programs. We are a vibrant, collegial faculty whose mission encompasses the fostering of creativity, diversity, and relational development.

**Responsibilities:** Conducting and publishing research in counseling journals; teaching master's and doctoral courses primarily in clinical mental health counseling and counselor education and supervision, offered in the daytime and evening, at either the UTSA Downtown Campus or Main Campus; writing grant proposals; collaborating with colleagues; advising students; and performing service activities.

**Required Qualifications:** Doctorate from a CACREP accredited Counselor Education Program to be completed by August 12, 2020; professional counseling identity; demonstrated teaching and research potential; and experience with and/or knowledge of culturally diverse populations. Moreover, the successful candidate must demonstrate their ability to work with and be sensitive to the educational needs of diverse urban populations and support the University's commitment to thrive as a Hispanic Serving Institution and a model for student success.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Eligibility for the Texas Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) credential and Texas Licensed Professional Counselor Supervisor (LPC –S) credential; experience as a mental health counselor; bilingual in Spanish and English; a record of publications; expertise in teaching career counseling; and a record of obtaining external funding.

To apply, please submit a) an **original signed letter of application** that **summarizes your qualifications** for the position, b) a current vita, c) contact information for three references who may be contacted immediately, and d) a research and teaching statement, which includes discussion on the role diversity and inclusion plays in an academic environment.
